The ideal person will have:

- Competence with donor management systems
- Experience in writing grant proposals, press releases and fundraising letters
- Ability to motivate donors
- Confidence in public speaking
- Commitment to the Purpose and Principles of the Religious Diversity Centre, with respect for the Treaty partnership and the multi-faith, multi-cultural diversity of Aotearoa New Zealand society.

This is a contract position for up to 12 months. The value of the contract is \$60,000 including GST.

The Religious Diversity Centre in Aotearoa New Zealand is a national centre dedicated to fostering understanding and appreciation of religious diversity among the religious, spiritual, and secular communities in the country.

The Centre's work is grounded in evidence based research. The Centre hosts the annual Religious Leaders Forum, supports the Youth Leadership Council Ngā Rangatahi o Māramatanga, organises Community Workshops and Professional Development seminars in religious diversity, and has a full resource centre together with information about the various RDC activities on the website, www.rdc.org.nz.

The Centre has an excellent relationship with the Human Rights Commission, the Minister of Diversity, Inclusion and Ethnic Communities and the Ministry of Ethnic Communities and the Minister and Ministry of Education.
